Hillsborough County, Fla. — The Florida Department of Health in Hillsborough County (DOH-Hillsborough) is lifting the advisory for high bacterial levels at the following locations:

Tests completed on Wednesday, July 30, 2025, indicate that the water quality at Bahia Beach, Ben T. Davis Beach, and Simmons Park Beach show an acceptable level of *Enterococcus* bacteria established by state guidelines. Test results are available at FloridaHealth.gov/HealthyBeaches.
