HIV testing is a crucial prevention strategy for expanding awareness of HIV status and facilitating engagement in care. For all Hillsborough community partners and Florida Department of Health (FDOH) staff involved in HIV services, a strong foundational understanding is essential. Currently, the HIV/AIDS program office is updating its certification process for HIV 500/501 courses.

Why is this training required?

Florida Statute 381.004 requires that individuals providing post-test counseling to patients with a positive HIV test result must receive specialized training. The HIV 500/501 training covers the special needs of persons with positive results and other topics at no cost.

Course Information:

- HIV 500/501 Counselor Training: A 24-hour training providing in-depth knowledge of HIV/AIDS, testing protocols, domestic violence, and enhanced client-centered risk reduction counseling skills to prepare participants to become HIV pre and post-test counselors.
 - FOR MEDICAL PERSONNEL ONLY: (MD, PA, ARNP, RN, LPN, RPh, PharmD)
 - Please complete the online training in TRAIN and send your certificate to CHD29Area6TRAIN@flhealth.gov to be enrolled in the 3rd day only class.
- HIV 501 Annual Update: A required yearly two-hour annual class covering updates to forms, processes, legislation, programs, and statistics for all certified HIV pre and post-test counselors.
